### **UPC Report**

Next meeting Oct 19<sup>th</sup>, meeting and update from superintendent. Presentation on great ideas for booster groups. Helps PTOs and PTAs not reinvent the wheel. They voted to support Yes for PV Students, putting information out there, Maintenance and operations (including salaries and daily operating budgets). 15% is budgeted through legislature, UPC needs to get support for it, there is \$9M at stake.

Can PVHS PTO support this? Suzy provided PTO bylaws. As a 501c3 we CAN NOT show support for any individual running for any office. "Yes for PV Students" is not for an "individual" so the PTO CAN vote to support it. However, if you are receiving the message concerning the PTO supporting "Yes for PV Students" on a school district computer or using a school district provided e-mail account you may not forward this message from your computer to another's computer or copy the flyer and distribute under A.R.S. §15-511, which prohibits the use of school resources in influencing the outcome of an election.
